- Provide title, author, start date, completion date, and number of pages in each book.
- Write <u>at least two reflections</u> for each book. This can be in the form of a character sketch, reflection on a quote, a summary, opinion, comparison, whatever you would like it to be.
- All of this can be set up in your Literature notebook or it can be written on loose leaf paper.

There will also be discussions and a test in September on each of these books that will be used for your first Literature grade!

*Please bring both books and your written assignments to school in August!!
